Cardinal Seán P. O'Malley has approved a proposal that would lower the age of confirmation within the Archdiocese of Boston from tenth grade to eighth grade.

We will be adapting our Faith Formation program over the next few years to transition in order to accommodate this change.

Here is what our program will look like beginning this fall 2024:

2024-2025 - Students entering 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2024, will receive Confirmation in the Spring 2025.

2025-2026 – Student entering 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2024, will receive Confirmation in the Spring 2026.

2026-2027 - Students entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2024, will receive Confirmation in Spring of 2027.

Going forward from there, all students in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade will receive confirmation in the spring of their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year.

Our curriculum and program will change for students entering the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2024, to prepare them for receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation.

We learn in the Catechism that *“Preparation for Confirmation should aim at leading the Christian toward a more intimate union with Christ and a lively familiarity with the Holy Spirit – his actions, his gifts, and his biddings – in order to be more capable of assuming the apostolic responsibilities of Christian life”*. CCC 1309.

Our program will contain an invitation and instruction on how to participate in the life of the Church as an expression of lived faith in the person of Jesus Christ. The expectation is that candidates have an earnest desire for the sacrament, openness to living a Christian life, and have been exposed to catechetical instruction and Christian practice at some point leading up to or during their preparation
